Today Chris and Fred headed back to Ontario and we were following them to the furniture outlet to help them load their new dining room suite. They wanted to be all packed up and get on the road by 9:00 and so the tardiness of the Travel Supreme crew couldn't have been at a worse time. By the time we were actually able to speak to a technician and have our Moho taken into the service bay; it was after 8:00. (You just know tomorrow they will be early!)

Finally by 9:45, we said our goodbyes to the Shaw's as they headed northeast and we headed back to Wakarusa. We spent most of our day enjoying the warm weather outside of the owner's lounge meeting and chatting with other folks here for service.
